

# VIAFIX: Open Porous Asphalt (OPA)



Viafix Open Porous Asphalt (OPA) is used by Transport for London (as shown in the photographs at the Bow Common



underpass/A13) in an area with a high water table. This allows the water to come up through the material and drain away, also used in the Dartford tunnel for pothole repair. This patch of Viafix OPA was added Nov 2011 and is still in place, other hot laid patches were only staying in place for roughly six weeks, due to pressure building up below the surface.



This is the only cold lay OPA on the market at this time, with the same high performance as the standard Viafix.
